BCHS 2022-2023 High School Course Selection Guidelines

Grade 10:

- 40 credit minimum (8 courses)
- Mandatory 5 core (English,Math,Social,Science,Physical Education)
 - These courses are entered by the office based on grade 9 teacher recommendations
- 3 option courses: Combination CTS and Fine Arts
- Grade 10's may participate in the Work Experience Program as long as it is not part of the regular school schedule (ie; collecting hours after school or on the weekends and or through the summer (Students must be 15 years of age and have completed HCS 3000)
- Chem 20/Physics 20 not recommended based on Math knowledge

Grade 11:

- 40 credit minimum
- All grade 11 students are pre registered in CALM
- Grade 11's may participate in Work Experience during school day with Administration
 approval
- English 30 and Social 30 not advised to be taken based on lack of course and diploma success in grade 11

Grade 12:

- 30 credit minimum as long a achieved 80 credits in previous 2 years and on track for graduation
- Work experience maybe part of grade 12's timetable with administrative approval

Grade 13:

• May be granted approval to return for semester one through administration. Minimum of 15 credits required to attend BCHS or Outreach if less than 15 credits. Adult students must register themselves.

The Learning Center (TLC)

Online courses may be offered through our learning center. They are scheduled as in any other scheduled class.

Not available to grade 10's Grade 11 may access one TLC block during the grade 11 year Grade 12 may access one TLC block during the grade 12 year *no TLC course will be offered for a course that is offered in person learning and fits within the student's timetable * a completion bond will be charged for any TLC course in the 2022-23 school year. The bond will be \$50 per credit taken. Money will be returned upon successful completion of

the course.
